### General Housekeeping

- \*We have had two really good rains and scuppers are plugged from the summer's "dust crop" preventing the rain water from leaving. Please be sure you are prepared for your boats winter wash down.
- \*Time to replace those torn and shredded tarps. Statistically they are acceptable for about one season this doesn't mean I year, it's about 3-4 months. .
- \*We have dehumidifiers and heaters available in the office for keeping your boat a little dryer for this "El Nino" winter. If you are looking for something particular, you can call or email me with the model number to see if we can save you some money.
- \*What's on your dock finger? There should be <u>"nothing"</u> on your dock or finger other than I set of stairs and a pre-approved dock box. All scrubbers, pressure washers, buckets, rugs, mats etc....will be placed on your boat for safe keeping.
- \*See a potential problem, please let us know. Your safety is our concern!

## Highway Closures or Road Issues:

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues to work on the Three-Mile Slough Bridge paint project on State Highway 160 south of Rio Vista and State Highway 12. One-way traffic control continues to be in effect 24 hours a day, seven days a week for north- and southbound directions. This will continue into late July 2016. Traffic signals with the use of cameras are installed and will be activated to replace the flaggers at a later date.

Caltrans secured the bridge to be closed to marine traffic from January 5, 2016 through April 10, 2016 due to construction below the lift span.
