## Recycling Update Effective May 1, 2018

As everyone knows, we recycle at the head of each dock in the green carts. The recycle service for our area is picked up every other week. This is very different for those of us coming from larger areas, and as you can imagine, can at times create problems in the Delta. Waste Management, our service provider, has provided us with a simple list of do's and don'ts for recycling, we appreciate your cooperation in making sure these new policies from WM are followed.

### Recycling Do's

- \*Do** recycle all empty bottles, cans, paper and cardboard
- \*Do** keep foods and liquids out of recycling
- \*Do** keep plastic bags out of recycling

### Recycling Don'ts

- \*Don't** bag your recyclables. Plastic bags and film get tangled in the machinery.
- \*Don't** include food-soiled items - they can turn an entire load of recycling into trash.
- \*Don't** add sharp or dangerous materials like needles and electronics.
- \*Don't** toss in "tangles" like rubber hoses and wires - they can shut down an entire recycling center.
- \*Don't** include bulky items like propane tanks or construction debris.
