



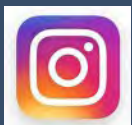

## Housekeeping for All

We would like to remind all who reside here at Owl Harbor some policies that are required to be followed in order for peace to prevail in the land (or at least here at Owl Harbor).

\*The 5 mph speed limit in the marina is not an option. I'm sure many of you are tired of reading this, I know I'm tired of writing it, but it continues. Please, look at your speedometer the next time you drive in, it's not hard but it will surprise you at how slow that is - consider this rule #1. First time warning, second time, you will need to park outside the gate.

\*Rule #2 there is absolutely NO PARKING ON THE LEVEE. You are allowed to load and unload - that means 10 minutes or so. If you park on the levee and we are notified by the Levee District or we have asked you to move your vehicle unsuccessfully, you will need to park outside the gate - ouch, starting to see a theme? When parking in the grass area, there is no parking on the hill side, please park on the flat.

## Housekeeping Con't

Rule #3 we have recycle and garbage totes at the head of each dock; use them accordingly. We will only take "regular" garbage and recycle items. Paint, life rings and other items you will need to take with you. Items you would like to get rid of that are still good, do not leave at the garbage area. Also, any items found, please bring to the office so we can locate the owner. Please breakdown the boxes for recycle, and ask us about other items that may go in the recycle cart.

Rule #4 you are responsible for your guests. All persons, clients and guests, entering the marina property need to abide by all the same polices.

## Rules of the Road

As a tenant of Owl Harbor, you are also a representative of what Owl Harbor stands for; that is respect, courtesy, and kindness. So, while driving in the marina on the levee road, or the back roads, (remember traffic goes both directions) please be considerate and pull to the side to let others go by. This is especially helpful with delivery vehicles, as they don't have anywhere to move like a vehicle can. This is another reason to do 5 mph in the marina.

## Time to check your Power Cord, Dock Lines and Halyards.

Fall is here and she has brought some strong winds. It is necessary to double check your boat to be sure she is safe and sound for the coming season. We will do our best, but the best safety check comes from you regularly; you know your boat much better than we do. We have lines and cords available in the ships store at the office if you need to replace some defective items.



# Updates

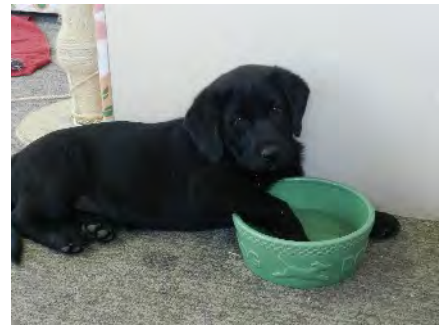
