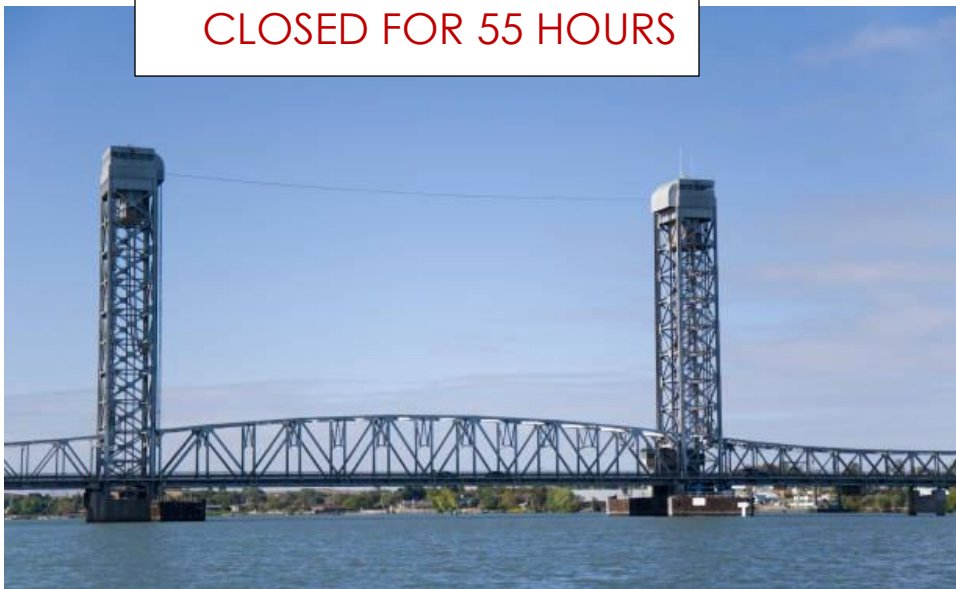


NOT SO GREAT NEWS – FOR VEHICLES
